US HISTORY

Learn about events and people from the time of Civil War Reconstruction through this 21st century. We'll use maps, reading exercises, discussion, analysis and historical sources to understand such topics as the progressive movement, immigration, the World Wars, the Great Depression, Civil Rights, the Cold War, Vietnam, and more recent conflicts. Includes preparation for the Civics Exam required for the high school diploma. This course counts towards 1 U.S. History Credit. Class meets on Mondays, from September 8 to December 22, 2025 from 5:30 - 8:30 p.m.. Note: the Civics Exam will be offered on 12/1 and there is no class on 12/8. A class project work session will be held on 12/15, and the final class will meet on December 22.

REAL WORLD ENGLISH

Being able to communicate clearly and effectively has always been important. This course provides students with an opportunity to explore and expand their knowledge and skills and relate techniques to real-world situations. Understanding the purpose and value of newspapers, completing job applications, and creating cover letters and resumes are some of the areas we'll explore. Reading, writing, speaking, and critical thinking - all facets of language arts -will be examined and utilized throughout. We'll also delve into the writing process and address what I call G.U.M. (grammar, usage, and mechanics). This class counts towards 1 English credit. Class meets on Tuesdays from September 9 to December 16, 2025, from 5:30 - 8:30 p.m.

Supported Online Instruction

Edmentum PLATO is an online learning program with a great array of subjects to satisfy required or elective credits. Each PLATO course is self-paced and completed independently. The ADP instructor will be available to support students during the scheduled class time and will monitor and assess all online work. Plato classes are accessible 24/7. The average student may spend as many as 50 hours to complete a course (0.5 or 1 Credit). Class meets on Tuesdays from September 9 to December 16, 2025 from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.

MATH APPLICATIONS IN SCIENCE

This course is designed to allow students to apply math and science concepts to real-world issues and problems in the fields of biology, physics and chemistry. We will review math topics including using formulas, ratios, percentages, scientific notation, and probability. This class counts towards 1 Math or 1 Science credit. Class meets on Thursdays from September 11 to September 18, 5:30 - 8:30 p.m.

FEE CATEGORIES (please circle one)

- 1. Night Student/Option 1 A 16/17 year old student pursuing the Keene Community Education Adult Diploma through evening classes only, but still considered enrolled in their home high school (Most home schools pay the tuition for these students. If not, \$215).
- 2. Dual Enrolled/Option 2 a 16 to 18 year old student never withdrawn from high school, pursuing the Keene Community Education Adult Diploma diploma through daytime high school classes and Community Education evening classes (Most home schools pay the tuition for these students. If not, \$215).
- 3. Home Schooled Student/Option 3 a home schooled student aged 16 or 17, not affiliated with a public high school (\$215).
- 4. Adult//Title II Student/ADP A student 18 years or older taking classes to earn an Adult Diploma (no charge).
- 5. In-school Youth Still enrolled in high school and taking an additional class for credit to transfer back to the high school with the goal to accelerate graduation date. Intends to graduate from their home school, and takes no more than 2 classes (\$215).
