There is open enrollment for classes during the school year. Classes are **FREE** for New Hampshire adults needing high school credentials or English skills. Enrollment requires an interview and pre-testing. Post-testing and follow-up surveys are required after completion.

HiSET at Night - Tuesdays, January 14 - May 13, 5:30 pm-7:30 pm

Designed for students who want a **fast-paced** review of **HiSET** content in all 5 testing subjects. Students will be pre-tested in **HiSET** practice tests to pinpoint areas of study needed to pass the official tests. Students are expected to complete additional **HiSET** review outside of class.

HiSET Prep - Thursdays, January 16 - May 15, 9:00 am-noon

Instructor - Linda Morehouse

Designed for students who are preparing for the official **HiSET** tests. The class includes a comprehensive review of adult literacy and math skills, including reading for comprehension, grammar/usage, language mechanics, writing a five-paragraph persuasive essay, algebraic equations, geometry, and number concepts.

Keene Community Education offers HiSET testing on the third Monday and Tuesday of each month between 12:00 noon and 5pm.

Spring 2025 Test Dates:

January 14, February 17 & 18, March 17 & 18, April 21 & 22, May 19 & 20

Students 18 and older should create a HiSET account at HiSET.org, and then register and pay for the test online. Each of the five subtests is \$25. You will need a government-issued ID to register for the test.
